

## IN-KIND DONATIONS

In 2023, Konbit Sante consigned eight container shipments of donated essential medicines, supplies, food, and medical equipment - including 500 new wheelchairs, an oxygen generation plant, and an ambulance—to Cap-Haitien. The items in these shipments have been identified by our partners in Haiti as critical to their ability to provide care. We are always looking for essential items like those noted above and below. ## Items Needed for Donation

These are some examples of useful donations.

### Medical Equipment

- Oxygen concentrators
- Ultrasound or sonography machines
- Vitals monitors
- Exam tables
- Hospital bed mattresses
- Propane refrigerators
- Crash carts
- Rehab and exercise equipment
- OR lights
- Infant incubators
- Infant warming tables
- Therapeutic bilirubin lights
- Medical suction machines
- Breast pump systems

### Office Furniture & Equipment

- File cabinets
- Stackable waiting room chairs
- Small desks (4' wide or less)
- Fans
- Water coolers
- Laptop computers with Windows 10 or more recent

### Consumables

- Exam and surgical gloves
- Bandages & wound care supplies
- IV supplies
- Syringes
- Catheters
- Sutures
- Medical tape
- Infant suction bulbs

### Special Items

- Solar power equipment
- Student desks with writing surface
- Heavy-duty, top-loading washer with a large capacity

1. Please email us at [info@konbitsante.org](mailto:info@konbitsante.org) with a list of items you have that match our needs.
2. We will respond to your email promptly and will then contact staff in Haiti to verify that they can use your donation.
3. If we can accept your donation, then we will provide shipping details and donor letters for tax purposes.
4. When considering items for donation, please keep in mind that we handle the shipping from our warehouse in Portland, Maine, to Haiti, but in most cases, we are not in a position to pay for transportation to Portland. Exceptions to this might be for biomedical equipment or other high-value items.
